Scene: Living Room

Hojin, Yunjung, and Annabel sitting near the fireplace, looking at the book.

Hojin: (acting as if he finished a book) OK, Annabel, it is time for you to go to sleep.

Annabel: (yawn) Daddy, but when do I get to open my gifts?

Hojin: When you wake up in the morning. The gifts will be waiting for you to open them!

Annabel: But I want to open them now!

Yunjung: Annabel, we should thank Jesus before we open the gifts. After all, it is His birthday, isn't it?

Hojin: Mom is right. We should remember to celebrate Him. After all, Jesus is the reason for the season.

Yunjung: Annabel, let's go in with Mom. You can wake up to the smell of Dad's blueberry pancakes.

Annabel: Yes, Mom. Yes, Dad.

(They all exit)

Kristen: (springing up from her position and making sure they are gone on her tip toes) Oh, Elsa, wake up! They are gone!

Rachel: Well, if you want to talk about looks, my bow is nicer than your foil. It is bright red and just perfect for a gift.

Amy: I've got stickers. I am the best wrapped, and look at all my glitter.

Gina: Well, I'm hand-made with love and care.

Everyone: Oohh!

Steven: Guess you can't beat that.

Jake: (dismissive) Yeah, yeah, whatever. I still think big is

best.

Matt: Small, the best thing come in small packages.

Hannah: Foil, it is all about foil.

Rachel: My bow!

Gina: Handmade!

(The presents start arguing and a fight threatens to break out as they argue and shove, each sure they are better than the others.)

(John and Jane hurriedly walk in)
